Smart Donating

Donation Ins:

Your gently used or new, clean and in working condition items are gratefully accepted. Before you bring in your donations, please ensure you:

- Wash or dry-clean clothing.
- Test electrical equipment and battery-operated items.
- Include all pieces and parts to children’s games and toys.

Donation Outs:

We cannot accept these items due to safety concerns, government regulations and the high cost of disposal:

- Cribs, playpens, car seats, swing sets and baby walkers
- Wet or badly soiled clothing
- Mattresses, waterbeds, metal bed springs, bunk beds and hide a beds

- Damaged or soiled furniture
- Building supplies, car parts and tires
- Carpeting, underlay and linoleum
- Firearms and ammunition
- Hazardous household waste, chemicals, cleaners, tube lights, aerosol cans or paint
- Large appliances
- Exceptionally heavy furniture
- Console TVs and stereos
- Gas powered barbeques, lawnmowers, trimmers, snowblowers and motors
- Large metal and office desks
