- LED & LCD TVs, stereos and other small electronics
- Small tools
- Most sporting equipment
- Toys and games
- Books, movies and music
- Household goods
- Linens

PLEASE REMEMBER

- Goodwill takes new and used items
- Clothing needs to be washed or dry cleaned
- Household goods and electronics must be clean and in good working condition

DONATING DON'Ts

To protect the safety of our customers, donors and staff, we ask that you contact your local municipality to dispose of the following goods. We will not be able to accept them at donation centres.

- Wet or soiled clothing
- Upholstered furniture, or furniture that is soiled or damaged
- Console or tube TVs
- Children's items such as cribs, playpens, car seats, swing sets or walkers (due to Health Canada regulations these items cannot be re-sold in our stores)
- Mattresses, bedframes, pillows and duvets
- Building supplies
- Car parts
- Firearms and ammunition
- Chemicals
- Gas or propane-powered tools, machinery or equipment
- Window blinds
- Pianos
