# **NOT so GOOD donations**

#### 1. Items Legislated Against Resale

- These items have specific federal regulations prohibiting their resale, mainly for child safety or product compliance reasons.
- · Children's items and safety products:
- Baby gates and enclosures, swings, walkers, bath seats and bath rings
- · Strollers and carriages
- Playpens
- Highchairs
- Bed and safety rails for children's beds
- Cribs and cradles
- Booster seats and car seats
- Sports and recreation safety gear:
- Helmets
- Hockey face protectors
- · Lawn darts
- Home and child safety hazards:
- Large wooden playsets
- · Horizontal blinds with cords
- Tanning equipment
- · Children's apparel and accessories:
- · Children's jewellery
- Children's sleepwear or clothing with drawstrings
- · Other regulated items:
- Used cosmetics
- Personal stereo systems (portable disc players, MP3 players, iPods)
- · Toys with magnets
- · Toyboxes without lid stops

#### 2. Items Requiring Testing We Cannot Perform

- These products must undergo safety or electrical testing that we cannot complete.
- Large appliances (including fridges)
- Laptops and CPUs
- Ceiling fans

### 3. Items Only Accepted When in Original Packaging or New

- Accepted only if unused and in their original bag or box.
- Air mattresses (must be new)
- Christmas trees
- Tents

#### 4. Illegal or Prohibited Items

- Items we cannot legally accept or resell.
- Guns and ammunition
- Replica or play guns (paintball, BB, pellet)
- Fireworks

## **NOT** so GOOD donations

- 5. Potentially Hazardous or Unsafe Items
- These items pose health or safety risks for staff, customers, or new owners.
- Chemicals and pressurized materials:
- Aerosols
- Cleaners and chemicals
- Paint
- Propane, helium, and oxygen tanks
- · Furniture and bedding:
- Bed frames with springs (metal) and bunk beds
- Waterbeds
- Hide-a-beds and sofa beds
- · Damaged, stained, dirty or wet furniture
- Mattresses
- · Vertical blinds with cords
- Large, heavy, or electrical items:
- Pianos
- · Fluorescent and ceiling lights
- Lava lamps

- Halogen lamps
- · Console, tube or non-flat screen televisions
- Water coolers
- · Building and mechanical materials:
- Barbecues
- Building supplies and construction materials
- Car parts and tires
- Motors
- Toilets
- Gas-powered lawn mowers, trimmers, and snowblowers
- Sinks
- · Carpeting, linoleum rolls, and underlay
- Other:
- · Wet or soiled clothing or furniture
- Medical supplies
- · Personal care items
- Ski and snowboard equipment with bindings
